Cost:

- **\$200 per team** (includes GST if any, covers entry and Ambulance Fee for up to 4 drivers at \$15ea & Club Day Membership if required for up to 4 drivers at \$10ea)

- **Current (2017/2018) SNZ Licence.**

Each driver must have a SNZ Licence.

One day licences can be issued on the day, or are available in advance from www.speedway.co.nz One day licence is \$60 per driver.

SNZ season licences are ONLY AVAILABLE ONLINE this year, and must be done well in advance of the event.

Lap Scoring:

Electronic lap scoring (using the Dorian Transmitter) is required due to the number of laps. Please borrow a transmitter if required and install as per spec. Mounting boxes are \$15 through www.speedway.co.nz if required. Please contact a committee/club member if in any doubt about this.

Prizes:

Trophies will be awarded for 1st, 2nd, 3rd plus a prize for Best Presented.

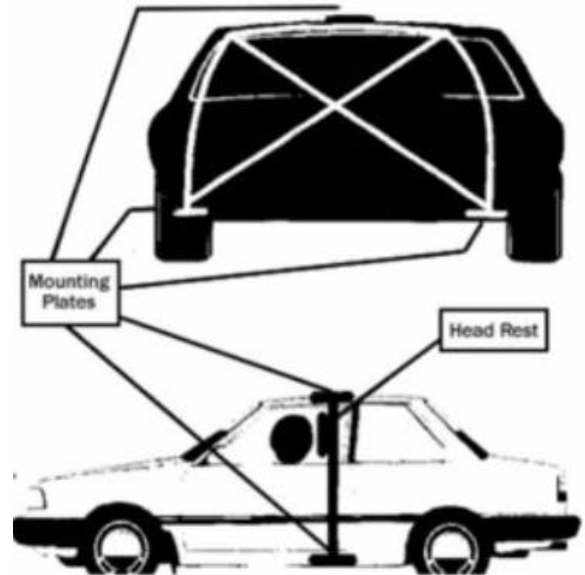
Notes:

Entry is at your own risk. While we have made every attempt to make this event as safe as possible it is motorsport and there is always a certain aspect of danger involved.

If there is anything you are unsure about please ask first so we can advise.

VEHICLE SPECIFICATIONS

- 1- All vehicles must be Rear Wheel Drive only, any Make of car.
- 2- All vehicles must be standard. No turbos or supercharges. Must have original size motor for that vehicle.
- 3- Factory rim size to be used. Road Tyres only, any width OK.
- 4- Exhausts to be under 95dba. Exhaust to have at least one muffler and must exit behind drivers door.
- 5- No locked diffs. This will be checked at Scrutineering.
- 6- All vehicles must be fitted with an interior roll bar (not full cage) fitted behind the front seat, above the drivers normal seated position, as per diagram. Rollbar material: 38mm OD 3.2mm wall thickness steampipe or RHS. Diagonal cross must be fitted inside roll bar. Rollbar to be mounted to mounting plates at floor and middle of roof. Mounting plates to be 125mm x 125mm x 6mm. A headrest 280mm x 150mm x 3mm to be fitted centrally behind drivers helmet and securely mounted to rollbar.
- 7- No extra bars in bumpers or chassis.
- 8- Any airbags must be disabled.
- 9- All towbars to be removed.
- 10- All head and tail lights to be removed.
- 11- All glass to be removed.
- 12- Windscreen: Protective mesh to cover the area immediately in front of competitor. Minimum 5.3mm diameter wire, maximum square size 150mm.
- 13- Cars may have rear vision mirror.
- 14- All interior trim and plastic to be removed.
- 15- Battery can remain in original position but must be adequately secured. If moved into the car then the battery must be contained within a secure box.
- 16- Standard pump fuel only.
- 17- Any cameras must be securely mounted inside the car.
- 18- Racing numbers must be in contrasting colour to vehicle and clearly visible on both sides of the vehicle and roof. Minimum size 300mm high x 50mm wide. Numbers to be applied for and issued following receipt of an entry form.
- 19- All vehicles must have (ELS) Electronic lap scoring box minimum 1800mm from the front bumper and minimum 600mm from the left hand side of passengers door. Mounting boxes are available from SNZ. SNZ transmitters will be required on race day – if you don't have one let us know so we can arrange something.
- 20- All vehicles must have seatbelts. Race belts or two diagonal seat belts can be used, but no retractable seat belts.



RACING RULES

- 1- Each team will have a minimum of 2 drivers, maximum of 4. Each driver can only do a maximum of 41 laps in any one driving stint. This creates a minimum of 3 pit stops for driver changes.
- 2- You are required to carry out 3 compulsory pit stops, teams can also pit stop at any time. If there is a driver change vehicle must remain stationary for a minimum of 3 minutes, if there is no driver change pit stops to be done safely with no time minimum.
- 3- No fuel to be added during pit stops.
- 4- This is strictly a Non-Contact race event. Racing rules as per SNZ Production Saloon racing rules. No deliberate contact will be tolerated. Any deliberate contact can result being black flagged to the pits for 5 minutes. 3 instances can result in disqualification. Minor driving infringements can result in a pit lane drive through.
- 5- Maximum speed 15 km/h entering/exiting and in the pit lane.
- 6- Any speeding or wheel spinning in the pit lane or any irresponsible behaviour by pit crew can result in instant disqualification.
- 7- A pace vehicle/water truck will be dispatched if a crash occurs during the race to allow for removal of the crashed car. Should you crash and are required to be towed but you want to repair the car and continue racing then you will need to be re-scrutineered before continuing.
- 8- No passing the water truck or pace vehicle.
- 9- There may be compulsory orange lights to water the track.
- 10- Alcohol is not allowed in the pits.
- 11- All drivers must wear full length, long sleeved overalls, Not nylon. Boots or shoes must be worn, Not Jandals or Sneakers. SNZ approved helmet must be worn. Gloves & Neck Brace also required. Clothing to be approved by the Steward on the day.
- 12- All decisions taken by the Officials will be final and binding and no protests will be entered into.
- 13- Competitors must have proof from the issuing authority that they hold at least a restricted civil drivers licence or a speedway racing licence. Competitors under 18 years must have a signed consent by a parent or guardian.
- 14- All competitors must be aware and accept that they compete at their own risk.
