## Conditions of Entry

**Rules:** This event will be run according to the current Speedway New Zealand General Rules & Regulations.

**Car and driver:** All competitors must hold a valid Speedway NZ licence and all vehicles must comply with the current Speedway New Zealand Rulebook and Supplementary Regulations.

**Sound:** A noise level of 95dba will be enforced and measured in line with the SNZ rulebook.

**Electronic Lap Scoring/ Raceivers:** will be used. All vehicles must use a transmitter and any without will not be permitted to race – transmitter must be working. Eastern States Speedway does not provide transmitters. You must have your own functioning Raceiver in accordance with the rules, and please bring spare batteries with you.

**Smoking** is prohibited in the pit area at all times unless in one of the three approved areas, to the left or right of the MTF tower or in the Pit crew viewing area in turn one.

**Numbers:** If more than one car enters with the same race number, you will be notified and asked to choose an alternative race number for this event.

**Event sponsor decals** may be affixed to each entered car.

**Postponement:** In the event of a rain out this event will be rescheduled to Saturday 29<sup>th</sup> February 2020.

**Format:** The promotion reserves the right to alter the closing date or format to an SNZ approved format after consultation with SNZ if deemed necessary. You will be notified of any such changes.

**Entries close:** Friday 31<sup>st</sup> January 2020. Late entries may be accepted, accompanied by a non-refundable \$50 late entry fee as per rule M4-7-1(iv). No phone entries will be accepted.

**Change of plans:** In the event that you have submitted an entry and are unable to attend, you must notify the promotion in accordance with the rules.

**Festivities:** Alcohol cannot be consumed in the pits. The clubrooms will be open after the conclusion of racing. Driver & team support of the clubrooms would be much appreciated.

**Security:** The promotion reserves the right for security to inspect any or all vehicles entering the venue.

**Pit Entry:** Eastern States Speedway has a closed pits area, all drivers will be required to sign their pitcrew in to receive their armbands to enable them to be in the pits area during racing. Closed toed shoes are required to be worn in the pits at all times. All children in the pits aged 11 years old or under are required to wear a high vis vest or clothing and have an armband.

**Technical Inspections:** Please pay attention to rules E2-3-1 to E2-3-9.

### **Meeting Format**

#### **M4-28-1 Qualifying**

a) Qualifying for the finals to be a minimum of two heats, marble and reverse draw, per group, over a maximum of 20 laps per race.

(b) Repechages may or may not be run at the discretion of the host track or promoter. Where repechages are included the highest unqualified competitors start from the front of the grid. (c) Two repechages are required when more than 36 entries are received.

#### **M4-28-2 Finals**

(a) Finals to consist of 20 competitors, racing over three heats.

(b) No competitor can be seeded directly into the finals

(c) Points are awarded as per finishing position from 20 points for first to 1 point for 20th, regardless of whether the car crosses the finish line.

(d) Highest point scorer over three heats is the winner.

(e) In the case of a tie on points for first, second or third place overall, there will be a 4-lap run off.

(f) Grid draws are as per diagram right:-

(g) If there are less than 20 entrants, the above grid system can be used for any number of cars. Use the bottom half of the grid from column 1 as the top half of column two. Column three uses even numbers highest to lowest then the odd numbers from highest to lowest.

**\*Qualifying will only be run if there are more than 20 entries received by the entry close date.**

### **Prizemoney and Awards**

Prizemoney will be paid out to via internet banking so please ensure your bank details are provided on your entry form. Sashes will be awarded to the top three finishers in the clubrooms after the event, with an SNZ certificate arriving in due course.
